Hendersonville – The Henderson County Sheriff's Office is investigating an armed robbery which occurred at 2104 Kanuga Road, at the Exxon Station, located at the intersection of Kanuga Road and Price Street. The Henderson County E911 Center received the call at approximately 6:29pm and officers were dispatched to that location. The suspect displayed a knife while in the process of committing this robbery.

Personnel with the Sheriff's Office are searching for a white male, in his early 20's, with a medium build, weighing approximately 150 pounds. He is described as having brown eyes, dark medium length hair and a dark full mustache. The suspect was last seen wearing a dark shirt, dark pants (possibly denim), tennis shoes and a yellow ball cap with some sort of logo on it.

The suspect fled the scene on a bicycle with an undisclosed amount of money. Those with information about the whereabouts of this individual are encouraged to call Henderson County Crimestoppers at 697-STOP (7867) or the Henderson County Sheriff's Office at 697-4911. The suspect should be considered armed and dangerous.

It is our goal to make Henderson County as safe as possible and I look forward to the impending arrest and putting this issue behind us."
