

Sheriff Rick Davis announces the arrest of two Henderson County men in the home invasion and homicide that took place early this morning on Howard Gap Rd.

The men arrested are **Terry Lee Landrum -16 years of age of --- 870 Ida Rogers Drive**  
**Steven R Ramirez-33 years of age---- 711 Woodcock Ave**

The man still being sought is **Mykel Waters—17 years of age—92 G Cedar Bluff Apts.**

Each of the above listed men are facing the following charges;

**1 count of Second degree Burglary**

**1 count of First degree Burglary**

**1 count of Assault With a Deadly Weapon With Intent to Kill**

**1 count of First Degree Murder**

Investigations during the day revealed that prior to making contact with the victims at the Corn home at 2822 Howard Gap Rd. These suspects had broken into another residence on the property. This residence, a mobile home located at 2798 Howard Gap Rd. is owned by the Corn family, and rented to a Ronald Rudsill, who was not present at the time of the offense.

Obviously we can not comment or speculate as to the motives or many other details of this case. We have maintained communications with the District Attorney's Office and are very comfortable with our case and the line of investigation thus far. Case integrity must be the overriding factor pertaining to dissemination of information.

According to Sheriff Davis, "This has been a terribly difficult day. Our hearts go out to the Corn family in their suffering and loss. I am so thankful to the men and women of law enforcement; the State Agents, the Hendersonville Police Department officers, and our Deputies and Telecommunicators who worked so tirelessly and selflessly to bring this case to the point of arrests. I would also be remiss if I did not thank the many citizens who were so moved by compassion at the brutality of this event that they came forward with tips and information in an effort to support justice for this family. Community support played a significant part in solving this crime and I am very gratified by it."
