

At 11:29 hrs on May 15th, the Henderson Co Sheriffs office received a 911 call from the United Services Credit Union located on US 25 and Butler Bridge Road. The caller indicated that the Credit Union had just been robbed at gunpoint.

The suspect took an undisclosed amount of cash. He was a white male armed with a semiautomatic handgun.

He appears to be approx 6 feet tall and 200 to 220 lbs. He has dark medium length hair and a dark goatee. He was wearing a long sleeved baseball type t shirt with a grey torso and dark sleeves. He also had on khaki colored knee length shorts and athletic shoes.
