

The Henderson county Sheriffs' Office responded to a report of a stabbing that reportedly occurred at 753 Holbert Road in Henderson County. The call came in at 0225 hrs in the morning. Arriving deputies found the victim, 21 year old Adam Case suffering from what appeared to be multiple and severe stab wounds. He was treated by first responders and Henderson County EMS and transported to Mission Hospital in Buncombe County.

Investigators with the Sheriffs Violent Crimes Unit processed the scene and gathered evidence and witness statements at and near the scene. From what investigators were able to determine the incident evolved from a domestic disturbance in which the suspect, Andrew Taylor Gilliam a 20 year old male whose last known address is 86 Farm Lane and the victim. Gilliam arrived at the residence of his ex girlfriend and confronted the current boyfriend Adam Case of 8352 Boylston Hwy at knife point.

The suspect had fled the scene when officers arrived. He has not been apprehended at this time; however warrants have been issued for his arrest. The charge at this time is Assault with a Deadly Weapon with Intent to Kill Inflicting Serious Bodily Injury. The victim, Adam Case, is in critical condition at the time of this press release.
