

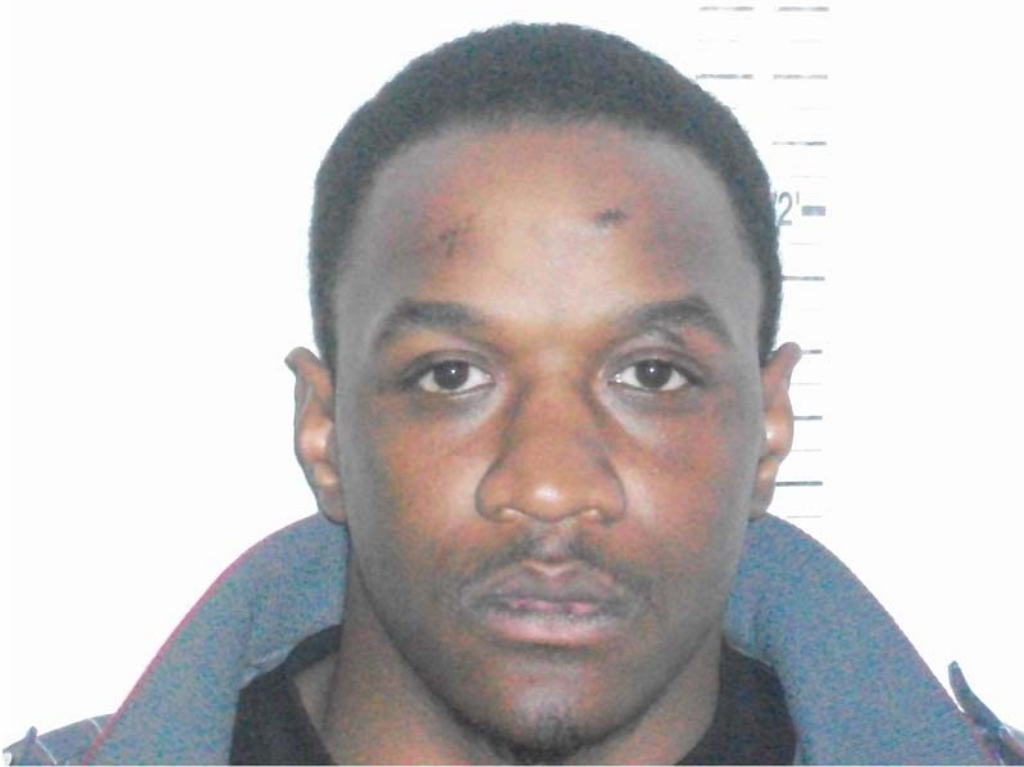
Henderson County Sheriff's Office Information Release

June 11, 2010

At approximately 12:40 a.m. on Saturday June 5, 2010 Henderson County Sheriff's Deputies responded to a 911 report of a victim who had received a gunshot wound during an armed robbery. Deputies arrived at 202 Cove View Lane and found Gregory Neal Osteen, Jr. with a gunshot wound to the neck. Osteen was transported to a medical facility for treatment of his injuries. The 911 caller stated that two black males entered the residence by force and one of them shot Osteen, and another person inside the residence was physically struck with a handgun during the robbery.

Sheriff's Detectives have been actively conducting an investigation into this incident and have determined the robbery and shooting was not a random act and appears to be drug related. One of the suspects has been positively identified as Charles Eric Alexander, Jr. Alexander is a black male that is described as five feet nine inches tall, D.O.B 11/02/1987(22 years of age) Warrants for Alexander have been issued for the following offenses, First Degree Burglary, Robbery with a Dangerous Weapon, and Assault with a Deadly Weapon Inflicting Serious Injury with Intent to Kill.

If anyone has any information concerning this investigation or the whereabouts of Charles Eric Alexander, Jr. they should contact Henderson County Sheriff's Detectives at 828-697-4911. Alexander should be considered armed and dangerous and anyone that encounters him should immediately contact law enforcement.
