

## Information Release

At approximately 5:50 p.m. on Saturday June 12, 2010 the Henderson County Sheriff's Office received a report of parental child abduction. The report filed by the victim's mother Amy Nicole Roberts stated that her daughter Catalina Isabela Serna had been abducted by her biological father Fabian Ezekiel Serna. Roberts stated the abduction had taken place on Friday June 11, 2010 at approximately 12:30 p.m. while the child was in the care of Elisa Serna, Fabian Serna's step-mother. The physical abduction took place at the residence of Elisa Serna which is located at 55 Old Dana Road in Hendersonville, North Carolina. Fabian Serna left with the child in a white colored passenger car that was described as a Pontiac Grand-Am.

Catalina Isabela Serna is described as a twenty month old Hispanic female with brown hair and brown eyes. She weighs approximately 25 pounds and has light colored skin. A photograph of her is attached to this release.

Fabian Ezekiel Serna is described as a 21 year old Hispanic male that is approximately five feet seven inches and weighs approximately 165 pounds with black hair and brown eyes. A photograph of him is attached to this release.

Serna is prohibited from contact with the child and her mother as a result of a Domestic Violence Protective Order that was issued against him. Current information suggests that Fabian Serna may be headed for Buncombe or Counties, but may have the resources to travel out of state to either Texas or Florida. Warrants have been issued against Fabian Serna for Felony Child Abduction and a Violation of a Domestic Violence Protective Order.

The Henderson County Sheriff's Office is working with the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children and a bulletin has been issued with Catalina and Fabian Serna's information.
