Henderson County Sheriff Rick Davis announces an upgrade to the Henderson County Sheriff's Office website. The Sheriff's Office website now includes a crime reports feature. Sheriff Davis states "This enhancement will now enable citizens to go online and view reports that have been filed with our office."

The Crime Report will allow citizens to view a variety of reports that have been filed with the Sheriff's Office such as breaking and entering, larcenies, assaults, theft of motor vehicles and other offenses. Sheriff Davis states "This report also allows access to the location and information of registered sex offenders, to include their photo, name and address as well as physical descriptors."

The reporting is done by map and will allow the public to view the reports filed by geographic region. Once an area has been selected, the map will display flags that contain a code and the user will click on a selected flag and instantly view what was reported at that particular location. Site users also have the ability to sort information by reported crime and by date for periods of 3,7,14 and 30 days.

Sheriff Davis states "Using this web-based program allows one to be familiar with activities in their neighborhood. This will provide the users with a sense of what we may be looking for in their area. i.e. if a user looks online and sees several vandalisms reported, that user may have information we need to solve a crime."
